Session

Purpose

The Surgical Technology Information Session is to provide prospective Surgical Tech applicants with information regarding admission into Fall term.

General Information

- ▶ The Surgical Technology Program has limited enrollment.
- ▶ 36 students are admitted in the program which begins each Fall.
- ▶ Students not admitted must reapply to be considered for the next class

Application Process

- ▶ 1. Complete college admissions process.

Submit official high school, GED, or Adult High School, and college transcripts.

(College transcripts will be reviewed for possible transfer credit.)

Minimum Admissions Requirements

- ▶ 2. Meet minimum placement test scores
 - Score of 151 or higher on NCDAP or DRE 098
 - Complete DMA10-50 and score 7 or above on the NCDAP.

Placement test scores are valid for five years.

College English or Algebra courses with a “C” or higher may waive some of the test. Acceptable SAT, ACT, PLAN, and PSAT scores within the last five years may also waive placement testing.

Unweighted high school GPA of 2.6 or higher may waive placement testing (graduation within the last 5 years).

Minimum Admissions Requirements

- ▶ 3. Biology Competency with a grade of “C” or higher.
 - High School biology
 - Taken in the last 3 yrs., grade of “C” or better
 - College biology
 - Taken in the last 10 yrs., grade of “C” or better

- High School Classes
 - 10th English

 - Geometry
 - Chemistry
 - Biology
 - Adv. Biology

Related Experience

- ▶ 5 points – Completion of a College Level Allied Health Degree/Diploma
- ▶ 2 points – Completion of a College Level Allied Health course (last 5 years)
- ▶ 3 points – Completion of a Allied Health related certificate (CAN, EMT, etc.)
- ▶ 2 points – Health Occ/Med Careers course completed in HS (last 3 years)
- ▶ 3 points - Completion of a HS College Tech Prep Curriculum (last 3 years)
- ▶ 2 points – Completion of a college level microbiology course (“C” or higher)

- ▶ Letters will be mailed within two weeks to those completed a MAR Review. Please remember to keep all contact information current.

Letters are sent to everyone accepted into the program, alternates and students denied into the program.
